The CUSAT issued No Objection Certificate for starting the colleges under the aegis of CAPE. AICTE issued the viability certificate for starting the college. College of Engineering Kidangoor was established during the year 2000-2001 & the institution was in the 20<sup>th</sup> year of functioning during 2020-21 with full fledged facilities to run B. Tech courses in 4 disciplines & M. Tech in 2 disciplines.


