I. BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

Government of Kerala vide GO MS/136/2000 Higher Education dated 18/02/2000 accorded sanction for the establishment of the College of Engineering Kidangoor. The CUSAT issued No Objection Certificate for starting the colleges under the aegis of CAPE. AICTE issued the viability certificate for starting the college. College of Engineering Kidangoor was established during the year 2000-2001 & the institution was in the 22nd year of functioning during 2022-23 with full-fledged facilities to run B. Tech courses in 5 disciplines & M. Tech in 1 discipline.

In continuation with this, a five-day Aptitude and Technical Training Program for TCS recruitment has been conducted for the same batch in July 2022. A training session is conducted for the first-year students to enable them to join and activate LinkedIn premium account on 14/09/2022.
